Chapter Meeting Minutes, March 5, 2019

NORTH TEXAS CHAPTER, NATIONAL RAILWAY HISTORICAL SOCIETY, MINUTES, DATE: March 5, 2019.

The March 2019 meeting of the North Texas Chapter, NRHS was held on Tuesday, March 5 at the DeGoyler Library on the SMU campus in Dallas, TX. There were ten attendees at the meeting. The meeting kicked off with a tour of an exhibit of documents related to the planning and construction of the transcontinental railroad. Attendees viewed a collection of vintage photographs and maps of the area around the railroad.

Following a tour of the exhibits, the group went into a conference room, where Russell Martin, the Director of the DeGoyler Library, discussed the history of the library, its primary benefactors, and its collections of various artifacts, including copies of various NRHS Chapter newsletters. The library is currently cataloging the Middleton and Steinheimer photographic collections.

VP Skip Waters reported on activities being planned. The 24 Hours at Saginaw program, is scheduled for May 24-25, 2019, is going to take place at the same time the Texas State Railroad has a steam event. Hopefully the two events won't severely impact each other.

The Chapter continues preparation for National Board Meeting. It will take place at the Magnolia Hotel, which has been chosen because of its proximity to light rail lines, museums, the Bush Library, and other attractions. The meeting takes place Thursday, November 7 through Saturday, November 9. In addition to the Board meeting, the event will feature a reception, a tour of commuter rail operations in the DFW area, and a banquet. Hotel rooms are \$149 per night. Cost of the banquet has not yet been determined.

Hotel rooms, banquet, Heber Valley Railroad excursion, and Golden Spike ceremony for the 2019 National Convention in Ogden UT are now sold out. Projections are still for an extremely large crowd to attend.

The 2020 NRHS National Convention will take place in southern California. Additional details will be forthcoming.

The April meeting will take place at the Texas Western Model RR Club in Forest Hill. Directions will be published in future messages. The May meeting will take place May 7. Following the meeting, attendees were given the opportunity to browse the stacks and purchase books. Several attendees purchased books. The meeting adjourned at 9:30 PM. Jerry M.
